# FIRST CITY UC LAUNCHES FUTURE TECH LABS AND ESTABLISHES COLLABORATION WITH FUTURE TECH COMPANIES



First City University College (First City UC) launched two future tech labs as part of its ongoing effort to revolutionise the service delivery and curriculum at its Faculty of Engineering & Computing.

First City UC Director Tan Sri Dato' (Dr) Teo Chiang Liang, accompanied by First City UC's Vice-Chancellor Prof Dr Saw Sor Heoh and FEC Dean Assoc Prof Dr Chua Ping Yong, launched the two labs viz. Robotics & Al Lab and IoT & Sensor Lab in a ceremony held on 19 Aug 2022 at the First City UC campus.

The launch of the two labs was in line with the aspirations of First City UC to embrace future tech, not just in the delivery of its teaching and learning but also in research and development.

In conjunction with the labs opening, First City UC signed MoUs with two future tech companies, UBTECH Robotics Corp Limited and TMAS Technologies Sdn Bhd.

#### BECOMING FIRST AIDERS AT THE WORKPLACE

Safety and health in the workplace are keys to establishing a pleasant and secure working environment that could support a motivated and productive workforce.





First City UC's Safety & Health Committee, in collaboration with St. John Ambulance of Malaysia (SJAM), recently organised a first aid training for 28 staff members of the University College. The staff members, representing the faculties and the administration departments, attended the two-day training.

The training, titled "First Aid at the Workplace", aimed to train the participants in basic life support skills. Topics covered included Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), Choking, Bleeding & Wounds, Burn & Scald, and Fracture & Spinal Injuries. On top of this, the SJAM trainer also trained the participants on how to use the life-saving Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device.

The training consists of theory presentations, practical sessions and life-like simulations. The sessions equipped the participants with the knowledge and skills to handle various emergencies.

The training required the participants to sit for Written and CPR tests. The tests were to certify the participants as qualified First Aiders upon completing the training programme.



First City UC currently offers programmes in Business, Computing/Information Technology, Design & Built Environment, Engineering, Hospitality & Tourism Management and Mass Communication.


